Transport Subsidy for Students on FAS

Students on FAS are to follow the step by step guide below to redeem the transport vouchers monthly.

Step-By-Step Guide to Redeem Transport Voucherthrough Transitlink eVoucher System

1. When can students redeem the evouchers?

Students can only redeem the evouchers from the <mark>28th of the current month to the 10th of the next</mark> <mark>month.</mark>

2. Where to redeem the vouchers?

Students can choose to redeem the evoucher at any Transitlink Add Value Machines or Transit Link Ticket Offices located at selected stations such as Hougang and Serangoon stations.

For students who wish to purchase concession passes by using the evoucher and topping up the difference on their own, <u>this can only be done at the Transit Link Ticket Offices</u>.

(a) Through Transit Link Ticket Office

Transit Link Ticket Offices are located at selected stations. Please refer to the table at the end of this guide, or Transit Link's <u>website</u> for the list of Ticket Offices and their operating hours. **Please do not approach the SMRT or SBS Transit's Passenger Service Centre to redeem the evouchers.**

To redeem the evoucher

- Please produce your Student Smart Card (SSC) to the TransitLink officer
- Inform the officer that you would like to redeem a evoucher granted by your school.
- If a evoucher is found, the TransitLink officer will proceed to top up/encode the value/concession pass into your card
- For students who are given a top up voucher but wish to purchase a concession pass, please inform the Transit Link officer when handing over your smart card. You will then be required to pay only the remaining cost of the concession pass after deducting the value of the evoucher given by your school.

(b) Through Transitlink Add Value Machines (AVMs)

Please note that the Transitlink Add Value Machines (AVMs) are coloured Purple and found in selected locations only. It is <u>not</u> the silver-coloured ticket machines found in all train stations.
